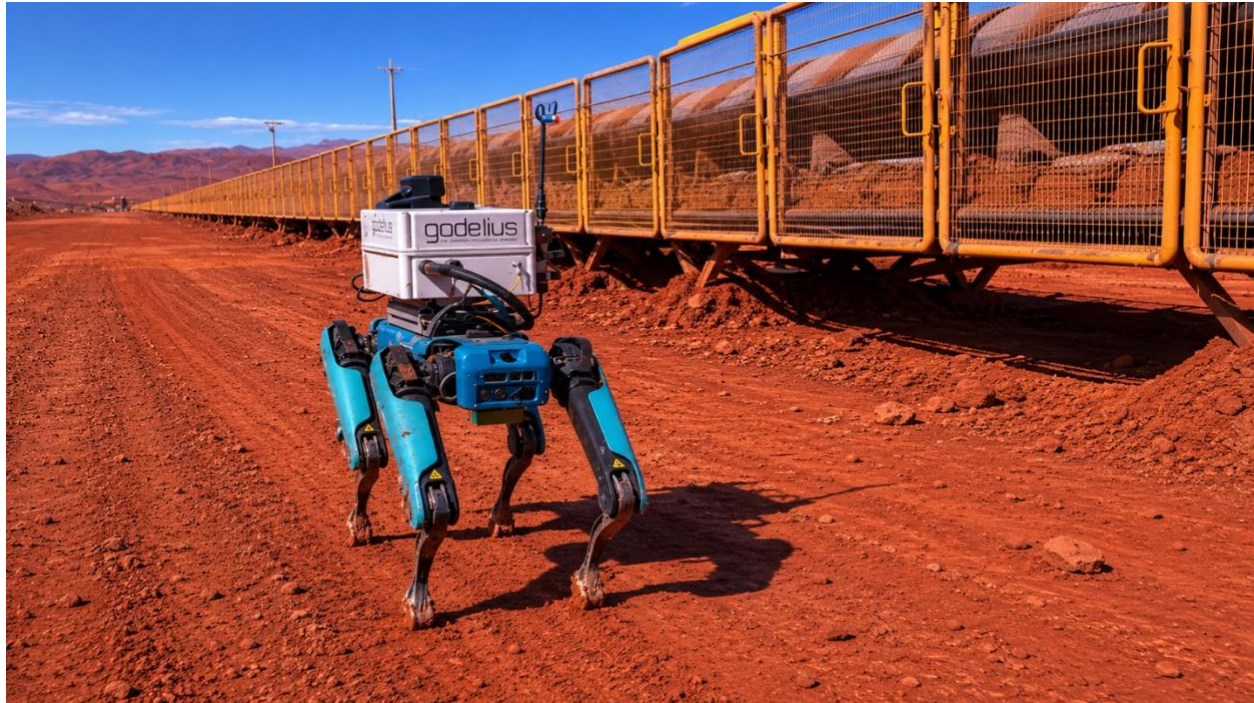


SK Godelius Partners with A.I. LAMB to Launch Advanced Conveyor Intelligence Solution in Australia

To support this strategic rollout, SK Godelius has appointed Sofia Pereira, an experienced robotics engineer. Leveraging her extensive background in field robotics and prior tenure with SK Godelius, Pereira will oversee mine site assessments, system deployments, and customer onboarding processes across Australia.
